REGULAR MEETING OF THE APLINGTON CITY COUNCIL

Aplington City Hall
October 11, 2023
6:00 p.m.

The Aplington City Council met in regular session on October 11, 2023. Jason Mehmen, Mayor, called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Council members present: Schipper, Jacobs, Lage, Meyer and Uhlenhopp.

A motion by Jacobs, seconded by Meyer, to approve the consent agenda which includes the agenda, minutes of the September 13 meeting, financial report ending September 2023, and a list of claims for approval, carried with a unanimous vote.

Travis Fleschner, A-P School Superintendent, spoke on the school districts updates and planning's in all three buildings, including the Aplington building. Mr. Fleschner and the AP School Board are committed to keeping schools in both towns. He also thanked the Aplington Ambulance Crew for their response to an incident during a high school football game.

A motion by Meyer, seconded by Lage, to approve the consent agenda, including the financial report, minutes of the September meeting, and approval of the claims as presented, carried unanimously.

Jeff Ridder, PWD, reported that the manhole on 5th street is fixed. A motion by Lage, seconded by Uhlenhopp, to approve estimate and payment to Finished Tree Removal for 3 additional deceased trees, and the IPAD in the electric lines for a total of \$8100.00, carried unanimously.

Department Reports:
Police- Status report received.
Ambulance – Frances Krull updated the Council on the reports/runs being sent through Image Trend. The City Clerk is working on obtaining a printer suitable for the IPAD. Logan Hovenga has been approved as a driver and is anticipating taking the EMT class.

Fire- An approval was needed for a topographic survey for the Fire/EMS building at the west proposed site. The Council did not approve having this survey done due to the fact the Council has not approved a definite site for the EMS/Fire building. This will be tabled until next month.

Library – The flooring is complete. There will be some additional re-wiring for the computer area. Due to the resignation of an employee, the library board will be hiring an associate to fulfill the replacement.
Holly Harken updated the Council

on the pool project. She mentioned that the monthly Sunday meals at the ARC will begin in November. City Elections will be held at the Community Center on November 7. Jason Mehmen is running unopposed. Three candidates are running for two Council seats.

The City has not heard from insurance on the playground equipment. The Community Club has submitted a grant request for additional equipment.

Discussion was held on changes to various ordinances. A motion by Uhlenhopp, seconded by Meyer, to repeal Chapter 41.12 Fireworks by eliminating personal fireworks displays, carried unanimously.

Continued discussion was held on Chapter 75 – All-Terrain Vehicles, Utility Vehicles, snowmobiles, and golf carts. A proposed revised draft copy was received. However, there was not a unanimous response from the Council members to approve such draft. This will be tabled until the November meeting.

Discussion was held on Chapter 151 Trees. The Council agreed trees that are planted in the right of way provide an attractive addition to the City landscape. However, to avoid any future expense by said trees, they would like to have more responsibility placed on the homeowner. This will be tabled until the November meeting.

A motion was made by Meyer and seconded by Lage, to draw up an offer to buy contract to Ryan Schipper for a 91'x700' tract of land south of the Pleasant View Cemetery (approximately 1.5 acre) at a price of \$7000.00 with half or up to \$250 included for a survey on said property. Motion carried with a roll call vote of all eyes.

Liquor licenses approved by Meyer, and Schipper for Stinky's and Iowa Party Barn, carried.

The health insurance renewal and the annual TIF report will be presented at the November meeting.

There being no further business, a motion by Meyer, seconded by Jacobs, to adjourn, carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 8:07 p.m.

Any voter who requires assistance to vote by reason of blindness, disability, or inability to read or write may be given assistance at the polls by a person of the voter's choice, other than the voter's employer or agent of that employer, or officer or agent of the voter's union. Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle.
Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on election day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the county auditor's office by 12 p.m. (Noon) Monday, November 8. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. ORDINANCE NO. 379
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF PARKERSBURG, IOWA, PROVIDING FOR REZONING OF AN AREA OF THE CITY from "B-1" commercial District with Conditions to "B-1" Commercial District with Conditions. WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on October 2, 2023, regarding the proposed change of zoning; and
WHEREAS, the proposed zoning is B-1 with conditions with the property currently zoned B-1; and
WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Parkersburg, Iowa held a public hearing on September 5, 2023, on the proposed change of zoning, and the report of the Commission is that it recommends that the property be rezoned from its present classification of B-1 with conditions to B-1 with conditions (with the conditions changing as described in Section 1 below).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARKERSBURG, IOWA:
SECTION 1. That the following described real estate situated in the City of Parkersburg is hereby rezoned from its present classification of B-1 with conditions to B-1 with conditions for all said property:
Description of the Property to be Rezoned:
Savage Addition lot 4 and N ½ Lot 5 of Block 5, Savages Addition to the Town of Parkersburg, Butler County, Iowa.
Pursuant to Code Section 165.60 the City imposes the conditions on the property owner that the space on Lot Four north of the existing building be used as a buffer zone with grass and trees, together with a fence should the City so request; that the additional construction of a cooler as shown in the attached drawing is allowed, but no other additional structure, equipment or

expansion is allowed; and that the decibel level from operation of the equipment shown in the proposed additional construction shall remain at or below the current level.
All other properties' zoning district classifications remain unchanged and unaffected by this ordinance.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
