action on the proposal to enter into a Development Agreement (the 'Agreement") with Butler-Grundy Development Alliance (the "Developer").

Developer is working in conjunction with the County to expand and pre-pare for development the Logistics Industrial Park ("Park") within the Butler County Logistics Park Urban Renewal Area in order to promote economic development and create and maintain jobs within the County. In furtherance of this goal, the Iowa Regional Utilities Association (the "Association") has expended \$1,283,076,00 to construct and in-

stall public water supply services

and public wastewater services to serve the Park and advance development therein, and the Developer is considering an agreement to reimburse the Association up to \$1,000,000 of those costs ("IRUA Agreement").
